Deferral of VAT	VAT payments will be deferred for three months (applies from 20 March 2020 to 30 June 2020).	UK-wide	All subpostmasters	 No action currently required from you. You will not need to make a VAT payment during this period. You will be given until the end of the 2020 to 2021 tax year to pay any liabilities that have accumulated during the deferral period. VAT refunds and reclaims will be paid by the government as normal. For further information or advice contact the NFSP on 01273 452324 (option 2). 		
Deferral of Income Tax payments	Income Tax payments due in July 2020 under the Self-Assessment system will be deferred to January 2021.	UK-wide	All subpostmasters	No action currently required from you. No penalties or interest for late payment will be charged in the deferral period.		
Time to Pay	Subpostmasters in financial distress can receive support with their tax affairs.	UK-wide	Subpostmasters who pay tax to the UK government and have outstanding tax liabilities.
