

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how the NFSP uses and protects any information that you give NFSP when you register and use the NFSP Forum.

Your membership number provided in your application form will remain private and will be securely stored and accessible only by authorised personnel. Your email address and other information you choose to post on the forum will not remain private. (Although an option not to share your email address with other users is available after registration.)

We collect the following information:

- Name and NFSP membership number
- Contact email address

We require this information to confirm eligibility to use the NFSP Forum.

You should be aware that your email address and personal information you choose to provide on the forum is widely accessible and may be accessible to the world at large and not restricted to the forum's membership. The NFSP cannot and does not guarantee that non-members cannot access the forum. Therefore do not post private information or information which is personal to you that you do not want other people to see.

You are also advised that the NFSP may use information included in your posts for marketing purposes in accordance with its general representative functions.

Save as above, the NFSP is committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable electronic and managerial policies to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. You may request that your postings are deleted by us from the forum upon reasonable notice of 7 days.
